Benefits

- Internal Service redesign in City of Edinburgh Council will create savings of £45 million in 7 years and create £70 million in capital receipts. It will also provide improved customer services. Shared service is an integral part of this new model.
- Shared services led by the NHS Lothian has created collaboration with other Councils decreased costs and improved service provision across the Lothians.
- The collaborative asset management model or 'smarter places' approach can be rolled out elsewhere providing a model for community redevelopment and linking services with assets.

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
