- III.2.1) Body responsible for appeal procedures**
Lodging of appeals
Precise information on deadline(s) for lodging appeals: The Contracting Authority will incorporate a standstill period of a minimum of 10 calendar days from the date that information on the award of the contract is communicated to tenderers. This period allows unsuccessful tenderers to challenge the proposed contract award before the contract is entered into. Such challenge should be intimated to Corporate Procurement at the address specified in part 1.1 of the contract notice.
